

REBEL RUNNERS CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP POLICY 2019

The purpose and aim of this Club Championship Policy is to provide guidance on how the competition is to be run and how members can monitor their position in this event throughout the year.

It is run with close adherence to our Code of Conduct Policy.

Due to the nature of the Club Championship being a competitive event, by participation it is agreed that members therefore give permission for their times to be collected from public race results, [Run Britain](#) rankings and [The Power of 10](#) sites. These will be used for the purpose of our Club Championship which is broken down into male/female and three age categories. This is open to all our affiliated members.

- Participation in the Club Championship is not compulsory. You will be asked if you wish to participate.
- You must wear your club colours when participating in CC events.
- Results will be displayed on the website and linked to the closed Rebel Runners Facebook group after selected events have been completed.
- Club Championships will run from 1st Jan until mid Nov, unless otherwise stated.
- An award will be presented to the male and female with the most points in the following categories; Senior <39, Vets 40-49 and Supervets 50+.
- It is your responsibility as a participant in these championships to advise us when you have achieved a PB at any given distance in this competition in order that the results are properly maintained; this applies at ANY competition that merits The [Power of 10](#) or [Run Britain](#) Ranking rankings status.
- Please ensure that these sites are updated with your achievements for them to be counted towards this completion.
- When a Club Championship event occurs, PBs will be taken from current records from [The Power of 10](#) and [Run Britain](#) Rankings profiles within 2 years of current date and points awarded accordingly.
